
## The VéloSoleX, more commonly known as Solex, is a legendary French motorised bicycle.

It released its first prototype with a 38cc engine on the front wheel in 1941.

Solex's simple and inexpensive motorised bicycles soon became popular among students and workers.

Over 8 million units were sold between 1946 and 1988.

Afterceasing production in France, the Solexhas been revived in countless forms including as e-bikes in 2005.
